

## Visitors Are Staying with Us Throughout November

UUs of Mt. Airy are hosting two families throughout the month of October. We're providing hospitality through our affiliation with **Family Promise of Philadelphia** (formerly known as PIHN—the Philadelphia Interfaith Hospitality Network).

**The facilities we'll be sharing:** The families will be staying overnight in two of the upstairs classrooms in Hale Hall. The families will have access to the fellowship hall kitchen and will use the fellowship hall for their meals. The families will also be using the new fully accessible bathroom and shower on the first floor in Hale Hall. The nursery room (directly across the hall at the top of the stairs) will remain available for the UUsMA religious education program throughout their stay.



**A new model of hospitality:** For this and future stays, the Family Promise of Philadelphia model for providing hospitality will be different than it was in pre-pandemic times. Under this new model, the families will be responsible for preparing their own meals and they will not rely upon volunteers to remain with them in the building overnight. These changes are designed to give more autonomy and responsibility to the guests while also being less demanding on volunteers from UUs of Mt. Airy.
