

# Philomusica Chorale Fundraiser at Iron Hill Brewery

Philomusica Chorale has set up a fundraising event through the **Iron Hill Brewery Restaurant at the Chestnut Hill location for Wednesday February 28th**. Through their "Give 20" program, Iron Hill will donate 20% of every check to our Chorale. (Note: alcohol is NOT included )

It is good all day during their regular business hours. The way it works is you and friends go eat there and bring a coupon either printed, or on your phone ([it's attached here](#)) let the server know you are there to support the Give 20 event for Philomusica and ask them to assign it to your check. Ask for a itemized copy of your receipt to confirm that the "Give 20" is there.

You can even use it for takeout - BUT only if you pick it up yourself or by your friends/ family. Just bring the coupon and show it or give it to your host as you are getting your food. You might want to tell them that it's part of the Give 20 when you place your order.

If you're eating in person, it's a good idea to reserve either on Open Table or over the phone. I would do this way in advance as the restaurant is a busy one and other people will be eating there as well. They have a small parking lot in the back. There are also several lots close by as well as street parking.

We've done this before several times and it's a very good fundraiser for us.

**A Final Note: Everyone must have the coupon in hand or on their phone before entering the restaurant.** You may **not** hand out the coupon to anyone at the restaurant- they have a very strict no solicitation policy.
