

Guide to Scans of HSP Collection 680

Collection 680 contains 60 Volumes regarding Universalism in Philadelphia PA. Most of the Volumes came from three Universalist congregations, namely:

First Universalist Church

Second Universalist Church (of the Restoration)

Third Universalist Church

Collection 680 also contains a number of documents from other Universalist groups.

Because of these only Second Church survives today, the present scanning effort concentrated on the documents from that congregation (which in 2022 changed its name to *Unitarian Universalist of Mount Airy*).

File Names

Each image is named for the HSP Collection, Volume and Page (where known - some volumes lack page numbers). Where multiple images of the same page are available, they are distinguished with subscript a, b, c, etc. A plus sign + identifies an insert, following a given page number (some of these are attached but many are loose).

In addition, the file name contains the year, month and day an image is referencing.

Consequently, searching can be done for a particular location in a volume or for a specific date.
